Building supervisors can open the relevant barriers and are also trained emergency responders.

#### Provide first aid

If necessary, move injured persons away from the danger area and ensure the accident scene is safe.



If an unconscious person is found, ask another helper to locate a defibrillator and use the device if the injured person has stopped breathing. (Defibrillators are self-explanatory and can be used by non-professionals)

The location of defibrillators is indicated on the plan of assembly points.

#### Other procedures

- Brief ambulance staff
- Instruct bystanders to leave the scene

#### **Accident insurance consultants**

If employees or students are involved in an occupational accident, they should consult an accident insurance consultant (Durchgangsarzt) appointed by the Unfallkasse Hesse and not their general practitioner:

#### Reporting an accident

If **employees** have an accident at or on the way to or from work, this should be reported to Mr Schneider of the Human Resources Management (Tel.: 1201) as soon as possible.

Students should report accidents that have occurred at or on the way to or from work as soon as possible to Ms Kircher.

Accidents at the University Sports Centre should be reported to the Sports Centre office.

# What to do in the event of fire

#### Stay calm



Use a fire alarm



This automatically alerts the fire service and triggers the building evacuation signal.

Do not forget to report the fire internally to the building supervisor!

If the fire service cannot be alerted using the fire alarm, please make an emergency call. (This generally applies to the rented buildings 23, 24, 25, 26, 34 and 35 where there are no manual alarms.)

#### Provide first aid

Alert persons who are at risk Help people in need of assistance If necessary, provide first aid Your own safety comes first!



#### **Guarantee your own safety**

If your own life is at risk and the alarm signal sounds, leave the building via the designated escape routes. Do not use lifts.



#### Assembly points

Go to the assembly point and let the rescue services know if all persons have been evacuated from the rooms.

Follow the instructions of the rescue services.

## **Building evacuation**

If the head of rescue operations or Presidential Board Office orders the **building to be evacuated**, all employees must follow the instructions.

Leave the building via the designated escape routes. Do not use lifts. Help persons with disabilities.
