
Directions to Fulda Transfer

By Rail or Bus:

The center is a 5-minute walk from the train station (ICE-Bhf).

Take the bus (lines 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9A, 9B or 591) to the bus terminal located adjacent to the Stadtschloss (city palace) on the street Schlossstr. The center is a 5-minute walk from the bus terminal.

By Automobile:

Autobahn A 7: Take the Fulda-Nord exit and travel on highway B-27 in the direction of Fulda. Keep to the right and exit at Leipziger Str. Follow the signs to Fulda-Zentrum. Drive about 1½ kilometers and then turn left at the traffic light immediately past the railroad overpass. Then turn right at the next traffic light. The center will be on your right.

Autobahn A 66 (from Frankfurt and highway B-40): Take the exit Fulda-Süd/B-27 in the direction of Fulda. Stay on highway B-27 for approximately 9 kilometers and then exit at Leipziger Str. Follow the signs to Fulda-Zentrum. Drive about 1½ kilometers and then turn left at the traffic light immediately past the railroad overpass. Then turn right at the next traffic light. The center will be on your right.

Highway B-254 (from Alsfeld/Lauterbach): Once you enter Fulda's city limits you will pass under a tall, arched railway bridge. Turn left at the second traffic light past this bridge. Follow the signs to Stadtmitte (downtown) and Bahnhof (train station). You will pass through a tunnel after which you turn right at the traffic light before the railroad overpass. Then turn right at the next traffic light. The center will be on your right.

By Air:

Frankfurt Airport is the nearest and offers direct InterCity (IC) and InterCity Express (ICE) rail service to Fulda, as well as regional train connections via Frankfurt's main train station (Hauptbahnhof).
